Daryl Stewart returned with his wife, son, daughter-in-law and granddaughter Kelsay. Kelsay did well in the junior division and Tracy took several awards as well. We are glad you came back Daryl and brought the family. A good family doing things together, and that's how is supposed to work. Visited with a gentleman from the Cisco area; had two sons in tow. They were down on the range; up at Marvins checking out the merchandise and just seemed to be having a blast. I expect to see them back for the June State Championship shoot. Also visited with several folks who participate in other disciplines of the sport but were here to see how they like our game. I think they all felt welcome and hope they are making plans to return.

Over the years we have been blessed with various members donating fundraising items and a lot of good folks who bid at the auctions and buy the raffle tickets for our efforts to improve TMLRA. This year has been exceptional in that area. Davie and Frances Boultinghouse delivered three of their handmade hunting knives to the range house on Friday morning. Davie wanted a knife to be raffled off at this shoot, another at the June shoot and the third at the October shoot, with all proceeds going to the Capitol Improvement account. For a donation of \$2.00 a ticket, you have the opportunity to be drawn for one these beauties just prior to the Sunday awards. Well we have raffled off the first of the knives during the March shoot that generated over \$400.00. The lucky scoundrel Toney Urban won my knife! On Sunday, Davie and Frances donated another fundraising item earmarked specifically for the Capitol Improvement fund, a 40 caliber fullstock rifle recently completed by Davie. It is a masterpiece folks. Anyone who has been around this outfit for any length of time is aware of the extremely high quality and highly sought after knives and rifles produced by the Boultinghouses. Since we have the beautiful quilt raffle this year and the other two knives, we will give away Davie's rifle at the October 2011 shoot. This should give TMLRA a chance to peddle tickets

for a full shooting year to maximize the fundraising effort and not compete with the quilt and the knives we have this year. There is a limit to what most folks can or will spend for this type of thing.

THE QUILT! The big raffle for the Capitol Improvement Fund this year is the TMLRA quilt. I have visited with Dave Nueses, husband of Rhonda Nueses, one of the primary folks making this happen. Rhonda Nueses, Rhonda McCartney and several other members are behind the quilt project. Several folks contributed ideas and pictures that were scanned and printed onto fabric sheets to make the squares. I viewed a picture of the quilt; you will be amazed at how good this is. There are 75 pictures of the old timers, new comers and everyone in between, from the Judge to the junior shooters. Rhonda Nueses has been making the picture squares and placing them on the quilt. Lots of hard work has been put into this quilt so give Rhonda and all the folks who played a part in this a big THANKS. It will be an emotional piece when you see some of the folks on this quilt and it is heirloom quality. Chances are \$5.00 each or 5 for \$20.00. Tickets should be included in this Swap Sheet. We raised over \$200.00 at the March shoot for the quilt and will be getting in to high gear on this between now and the October shoot. It will be drawn for at the October auction. Lets see what we can do on this quilt! Be sure and thank the gals that worked so hard on this.

SWAP SHEET - I know that not all of the members are receiving the Swap Sheet by the phone calls and emails I am getting. OK, we are having to scrap what we thought was good idea to save money for TMLRA by posting the Swap Sheet to the website and saving the printing and the postage, which comes to about \$1.50 per issue depending on how many pages, etc. It was never intended for all members to get the Swap Sheet from the website. For those of you who can get it from the website, you are helping to cut costs for TMLRA and as time goes by we expect to get more members going to the website for Swap Sheet. We realize that some members will have to be mailed out hard copy, but that's fine, remember you paid your dues! Some members have invalid addresses in our records, whether web or US Mail. Help us get your current addresses so you can get your Swap Sheet! The Swap Sheet Editor and I are committed to see that each of you receives the Swap Sheet. The combined duties of keeping the website up and going, updated, etc and trying to publish the Swap Sheet are a big load for one person. One of our newer TMLRA members, Larry Connelly, has agreed to step up and assist the Editor in getting this Swap Sheet out to all members. Toney and I appreciate Larry's willingness to help us on this.

Texas State Championship Matches - The Granddaddy of TMLRA's annual competitions is just around the corner in June. Get the gear rounded up, balls molded and mark the calendars! We will have a TMLRA Board of Directors Meeting on Friday June 11<sup>th</sup> at the Brady Chamber of Commerce office, 6:00 PM. We will elect 5 new Directors and address the business of the association. I want to thank Lisa Zirkle for spending a lot of her time assisting with the computer programs, general duties and basically helping Bonnie keep things running smooth in the rangehouse. I apologize for being a little wordy, just had a lot to say this time. Thanks to all who contribute to the great organization we know as the TMLRA.

**RANGE RULES**

1. All matches will be fired in a single relay, except bench rest matches identified in the program.
2. Sighters are allowed in all matches.
3. Minus scores count as zero.
4. N.M.L.R.A. rules shall prevail, with these exceptions:
  - a. Minnie balls only in musket matches.
  - b. Muskets are allowed to have wood removed from the stock.
  - c. 60 and over years of age can use any metallic sights in any match.
  - d. Targets must be completed in the relay or series of relays in which the first scoring shot is fired.
  - e. No shooting jackets are allowed.
5. Rule books maybe purchased at the range house.
6. Each person **MUST** score their own targets before turning them in to the range officer.
7. Targets will be turned in at the end of each relay.
8. All relays will be 30 minutes long.
9. Relays will begin at 8:00 am. No relay will begin after 5:00 pm. The last relay Sunday will be the relay, which ends closest to noon.
10. Agg. Fees must be paid before any match in that Agg. Is shot.
11. All buffalo guns and muskets will need to be inspected before any of those matches are shot, see the range chairman, range officer or the president.
12. Men and women must load their own gun. Assistants may not shoot for juniors.
13. Shooters must have their own frame. One Shooter per frame.
14. Juniors under 16 may purchase matches or aggs in the under 16 years of age divisions and do not pay a \$5.00 registration fee.
15. Juniors participating in non-junior aggs must pay the registration fee.
16. Individual matches purchased do not apply toward the aggregate award unless an aggregate is purchased.
